Dopamine: a cognitive mechanism at the crossroads of perception, action and emotion. Dopamine neurons are involved in reward and reinforcement learning processes, and may play a role in attention, as well as in flexible emotional responses. Here we discuss the cognitive functions of dopamine and its neurotransmitter, hypothesizing that the central importance of this neurotransmitter for reward, attention, emotional processes and learning may be its property to integrate these functions. We propose that dopamine may integrate perception and action, emotion and learning, and present arguments that it can be interpreted as a multiple-route, parallel, learning system. We also propose that the monoaminergic drugs amantadine and methylphenidate act, respectively, by correcting and enhancing dopamine transmission at the levels of the dopaminergic neurons, of the target cells, of the perception-action loop, and of the affective-learning loop. The therapeutic value of these drugs and their side-effects are discussed. The pharmacological manipulation of dopamine systems may thus give valuable insights into the functional organization of the brain., and simultaneously provides opportunities for the state to monitor citizens' constitutional rights, the absence of which has been a problem for much of our history.
